You have expressed interest in being awarded a Graduate Student Service Appointment, Fellowship, or Traineeship administered by the University. You may apply for one of these awards by completing this application form and then sending it to the **chairperson of the department in which you expect to carry out your graduate study.**

Appointment to a Teaching, Research, or Staff Assistantship or Associateship, Fellowship, or Traineeship is contingent upon admission of the student to the Graduate School prior to the beginning of his/her service or award. Continuation or reinstatement of an appointment is contingent upon good standing in the Graduate School as determined by the Dean of the Graduate School.

Assistantships ordinarily require participation on a half-time basis in teaching or research programs. Assistants are required to register each quarter for not less than nine (9) credits applicable to their advanced degrees. Stipend levels for Graduate Student Service Appointments are published annually, and conditions of service are set forth in publications available in departmental offices and in the Graduate School. Fellowships and Traineeships are awarded only in certain departments and carry varying stipends.

NEED BASED FINANCIAL AIDS (Loans, Work-Study)--requires a separate application which may be obtained from the Student Financial Aids Office, 105 Schmitz Hall, Box 355880, University of Washington. Students should meet the application deadline even if they have not yet been admitted to the Graduate School.

EXTERNAL FUNDING OPPORTUNITIES--these competitions require direct applications from the student. The following reference guide is an excellent source of information on specific programs of funding:
